Sub : Enhancement of Capacity of M/s. Vikram Solar Ltd. -reg

M/s. Vikram Solar Ltd., a manufacturing unit of Falta SEZ, holding LOP NO.FSEZ/LIC/V-19/2013/399 dated 25.04.2013 has requested for enhance their installed capacity for Manufacturing of Module (Solar Module) vide their letter No. VSL/UNIT II/2021-22 dated 24.01.2022.

Subsequently, item ‘Solar Module’ included in the 1 st phase – 200 MW & 2 nd Phase-200 MW and Solar Equipments & devices including Solar fans, Solar lights, Solar Pumps, Solar Lanterns and Solar Power generating system and the production capacity enhanced by 400 MW (Solar Module) on 04.10.2016. Again, ‘Solar Module’ of 800 MW included in the UAC held on 15.01.2020]

Reason given by the Unit for such enhancement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • With growing Global Market demand, there is huge potential for Indian manufacturer-Exporter in the coming year. • Based on likely predictions of growth for the next decade, the solar module demand worldwide is forecast as about 375 GW in the next 3 years. These significant demand projections indicate excellent potential for the solar PV module industry. • The expansion would help the unit in meeting huge export potential and generation of employment in the region. • The US and European Markets have opened up in a big way and the Unit have received enquiries/orders to export modules of large quantities to be shipped in the next 18 months.
