Minutes of 140th meeting (1st meeting of the 2022 Series) of the Unit Approval Committee Constituted in terms of Section 13 of Sub Section 1 of the Special Economic Zone Act, 2005 held on **28.01.2022** at 12.00P.M. in the chamber of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone, 4th floor, 2nd MSO Building, Nizam Palace, 234/4, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata-700 020 through Video Conferencing regarding Falta SEZ, Manikanchan SEZ, Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Ltd. IT SEZ Kolkata, Wipro IT/ ITES SEZ and DLF IT/ITES SEZs. List of participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

Dr. B.K. Panda, Chairman & CEO welcomed all the members present in the meeting and requested Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy. DC, Falta SEZ to place the agenda before the Committee for discussion.

Item wise decisions taken were as under:

Agenda Item No. A&B: Ratification of the minutes of 138th UAC meeting held on 22.12.2021.

Minutes of the 138th UAC meeting was circulated to all the members of UAC. As no comments were received, the committee ratified the minutes and confirmed the same.

Agenda Item No.1: Request for renewal of Letter of Permission (LOP) No. FEPZ/LIC/A-37/2000/10835 dated 18.01.2000 by A.P. Fashions Pvt. Ltd.

The request for renewal of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-37/2000/10835 dated 18.01.2000 by A.P. Fashions Pvt. Ltd. was discussed. Shri Rajgopal Srinivasan appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The committee noted that the renewal of LOA was granted for 2 (two) years of 5th Block w.e.f. 10.03.2020 to 09.03.2022. The unit representative stated that due to Covid-19, they could not perform well, but by the end of March, 2022, their exports would increase upto 1.50 Crores.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve for renewal of their existing LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-37/2000/10835 dated for remaining period of 3 (three) years w.e.f. 10.03.2022 to 09.10.2025 as applied by the unit subject to compliance SEZ Rules, 2006.

Agenda Item No.2: Request for Inclusion of additional Items viz. "Mask, Sanitizers & Wipes" vide HSN Code 61171090, 34013090 & 34011990 respectively in existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/J-23/2012/2610 dated 11.10.2012 by M/s. Jiwanram Sheoduttra Industries Pvt. Ltd.

The request for Inclusion of additional Items Viz "Mask, Sanitizers & Wipes" vide HSN Code 61171090, 34013090 & 34011990 respectively in existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/J-

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23/2012/2610 dated 11.10.2012 by M/s. Jiwanram Sheoduttrai Industries Pvt. Ltd. was discussed. The representative of the unit appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The Committee asked the unit to submit the rental dues and Secretary, FSEZ Authority to confirm the same. The Committee also noted that the above items should form part of the packaged PPE Kit and should not be exported or sold separately. Further, it has been intimated to the unit that the HSN Code of the above items need to be changed to 63079090 for "masks" 38089400 for Sanitizer-Alcohol based and 34013090 for wipes as per policy provisions of DGFT.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve their proposal for inclusion of additional Items viz. "Mask, Sanitizers & Wipes" in their exiting LOA NO. FSEZ/LIC/J-23/2012/2610 dated 11.10.2012 with change in their HSN Codes as above and subject to condition that unit should register for sanitizers under Drug Control Authority and obtain NOC from Assistant Drugs Controller, before export/ DTA sale of the above item (sanitizer-alcohol based) even as part of packaged PPE kit.

Agenda Item No.3: Services supplied to Falta SEZ units for their authorized operations without charging IGST.

The request of availing default authorized services supplied to Falta SEZ units for their authorized operations without charging IGST was discussed in detail. The Committee approved the default authorized services mentioned against each of the units. Further, it was noted that whenever the other units of SEZ would like to avail the default authorized services, it should be placed before UAC for consideration.

Agenda Item No.4: Enhancement of capacity for Trading for Memory Card ITC(HS) Code No. 85235220 in the LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/C-36/2021/2076 dated 12.11.2021 of M/s. Cloom Trading Ltd., an unit in FSES-ratification-regarding.

The request for enhancement of capacity for Trading for Memory Card ITC(HS) Code No. 85235220 in the LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/C-36/2021/2076 dated 12.11.2021 of M/s. Cloom Trading Ltd., an unit in FSEZ was discussed at length. Shri Akash appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for increase in quantity to 5 lakhs for consideration. The Committee agreed to ratify enhancement of the capacity for Trading of Memory Card from 1.00 Lakh pieces to 1.50 Lakh pieces as already allowed by DC, FSEZ. The UAC also agreed to increase the total quantity upto 3 lakh only at this initial stage. Any further enhancement of capacity would be subject to breakthrough in realization of foreign exchange against exports made by the unit or evaluation of the actual requirement for the trade to the satisfaction of Development Commissioner, FSEZ.

Agenda Item No.5: Enhancement of capacity for Trading for Memory Card ITC(HS) Code No. 85235220 in the LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/C-35/2021/2775 dated 12.11.2021 of M/s. Crixcruze Impex Ltd., an unit in FSEZ-ratification-regarding.

Impex Ltd., a unit in FSEZ, was discussed at length and thoroughly examined by the Committee. Shri Indrajit Shaw appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal to increase in quantity to 4 lakh for consideration. The Committee agreed to ratify enhancement of the capacity for Trading of Memory Card from 1.00 Lakh pieces to 1.50 Lakh pieces as already allowed by DC, FSEZ. The UAC also agreed to increase the total quantity up to 3 lakh only at this initial stage. Any further enhancement of capacity would be subject to breakthrough in realization of foreign exchange against exports made by the unit or evaluation of the actual requirement for the trade to the satisfaction of Development Commissioner, FSEZ.

Supplementary Agenda Item No.6: Enhancement of Capacity of M/s. Vikram Solar Ltd., an unit in Falta SEZ, holding LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/V-19/2013/399 dated 25.04.2013-reg.

The request of M/s. Vikram Solar Ltd., a unit in FSEZ, holding LOA No.FSEZ/LIC/V-19/2013/399 dated 25.04.2013 for enhancement of their installed capacity for manufacturing of Solar Module upto 3000 MW was discussed in length by the Committee. Shri S. Ganguly appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The Committee requested the unit to submit the entire list of Capital Goods & Machineries to be imported. The unit stated that the proposed investment on imported machineries would be around Rs.450 Crores and an additional employment would be around 700 employees.

After due deliberation the Committee decided to grant provisional approval to enable the unit to proceed with the project while also directed the unit to make submission of all documents regarding proposed investment, machinery to be imported, employment generation and average annual power consumption. After submission of all required documents, the same may be placed in next UAC meeting for record in the terms and conditions of the final approval to be granted. FSEZ officer's visit will ensure on Machinery and Enhancement of capacity 3000MW of Solar Module, Technical point of view. Report will submit to UAC time to time.
