Minutes of 143<sup>rd</sup> meeting (3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the 2022 series) of the Unit Approval Committee constituted in terms of Section 13 of Sub Section 1 of the Special Economic Zone Act, 2005 held on 21.03.2022 at 11.30 P.M. in the Chamber of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, 2<sup>nd</sup> MSO Building, Nizam Palace, 234/4, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata-700 020 through Video Conferencing regarding Falta SEZ, Manikanchan SEZ Candor Kolkata One Hi-Tech Structures IT/ ITES SEZ and DLF IT/ITES SEZs. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure-I.

Dr. B.K. Panda, Chairman & CEO welcomed all the members present in the meeting and requested to Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy. DC, Falta SEZ to place the agenda before the Committee for discussion.

**Item wise decisions taken were as under:**

**Agenda Item No. A & B: Ratification of the minutes of 142<sup>nd</sup> UAC meeting held on 25.02.2022.**

Minutes of the 142<sup>nd</sup> UAC meeting was circulated to all the members of UAC. As no comments were received, the committee ratified the minutes and confirmed the same.

**Agenda Item No.1: Request of M/s. Mallcom (I) Ltd. for renewal of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/M-19/2021/13204 dated 27.02.2001 for manufacture of Nitrile Dipped Gloves, Industrial Garments, Leather Hand Gloves, Seamless Gloves with PU Coating from Falta SEZ.**

The request of M/s. Mallcom (I) Ltd for renewal of LOP FEPZ/LIC/M-19/2001/13204 dated 27.02.2001 for manufacture of Nitrile Dipped Gloves, Industrial Garments, Leather Hand Gloves, Seamless Gloves with PU Coating was discussed and examined by the Committee. Shri Somenath Roy represented on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The committee noted that the unit has achieved (+) NFE and there is no pending foreign exchange realization.

After deliberation, the committee decided to renew the LOP FEPZ/LIC/M-19/2001/13204 dated 27.02.2001 of M/s. Mallcom (I) Ltd w.e.f. 07.03.2022 to 06.04.2026 for 04(four) years and also ratified the LOA extension issued of the unit from 07.03.2021 to 06.03.2022 as applied by the unit.

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**Agenda Item No.2: Request for M/s. Midas DFS Pvt. Ltd., a unit in Falta SEZ for inclusion of items in LOA NO. FSEZ/LIC/M-37/2004/388 dated 25.04.2005 in respect of M/s. Midas DFS Pvt. Ltd.**

The request of M/s. Midas DFS Pvt. Ltd., a unit in Falta SEZ for inclusion of items in LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/M-37/2004/388 dated 25.04.2005 was discussed and examined by the Committee. Mr. Raj Goenka appeared on behalf of the unit before the committee and explained their request for consideration of their proposal for inclusion the new items. The Committee enquired about their procurement that whether it will be imported or procured from DTA. The unit clarified that they are trying to import from Bangladesh and some items will be procured from DTA. The Committee also clarified to the unit that no DTA sale of items would be allowed and there should not be any import or DTA procurement of old torn clothes/ old or used garments. Trading operation from the SEZ will be permitted only for export purposes.

After due deliberation the Committee decided to approve the proposal for inclusion Readymade Garments- ITC(HS) Code 6114, 62113911, 6111, 6117, 621040, 621149, 62114300 and 621142, as applied by the unit or any other item of clothings classifiable under chapter 61 or 62 of Customs Tariff subject to no restrictions on their import or export under the Foreign Trade Policy and subject to compliance of SEZ Act, 2005 & SEZ Rules, 2006.

**Agenda Item No.3: Request of M/s. Esscom Trade INC, for setting up a new Manufacturing unit in Falta Special Economic Zone, Falta, 24 Pgs(S)**

The request of M/s. Esscom Trade INC for setting up a new manufacturing unit in Falta Special Economic Zone was discussed and examined in detail by the Committee. Mr. Sanjib Saha represented on behalf of unit and explained their request before the Committee for consideration of their proposal. The Committee enquired about their items ( raw materials) and the unit clarified that the items are primary agriculture products. The Committee clarified that the unit will have to comply with Plant Quarantine formalities and FSSAI registration.

After due deliberation, the committee decided to approve for setting up of a new manufacturing unit at Falta SEZ based on their application in Form-F and along with project profile, as submitted by the firm in terms of provision in Rule 18 of SEZ Rules, 2006 subject to condition that unit should comply with plant Quarantine formalities, FSSAI registration and related formalities as prescribed by FSSAI authorities. Further it was clarified that minimum import value or Tariff Value of the Import of certain items should not be below base price. For example, Import Value of Areca Nut and Betel Nut should not be below Rs.251/- per Kg otherwise it becomes prohibited for imports. Besides Areca Nuts also attract Tariff value that as per current Notification No. 17/2022 Cus(N.T.) dated 15.03.22 is fixed at US\$ 5589 per MT for assessment purposes. It was also clarified that no DTA sale of the items would be allowed.

Further it is clarified that no import of any item falling under restricted or prohibited category as per HSN/FTP shall be allowed. Besides all imports shall also be subject to compliance of Port of Entry restrictions, country of origin restrictions and Wild Life Authorities inspection etc as applicable at the material time of import or export, as notified from time to time

After due deliberation, the committee decided to approve for inclusion of additional items viz “Face Shield” HS Code 39269099 in their existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/J-23/2012/2610 dated 11-10-2012 as a part of PPE Kit as a ‘last and final’ chance for inclusion. No further inclusion of items will be allowed for the PPE kit.

**Agenda Item No.5: Request for renewal of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-13/1992/979 dated 29.03.1993 of M/s. Antarctica Limited, a manufacturing unit of Falta SEZ for a period of 05 Years.**

The request for renewal of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-13/1992/979 dated 29.03.1993 of M/s. Antarctica Limited for a period of 05 (five) years was discussed and examined in detail by the Committee. Nobody appeared on behalf of the unit. The Committee noted that there is no performance in the last 2 (two) years.

After due deliberation, the committee decided to renew their existingLOA No.FEPZ/LIC/A-13/1992/979 dated 29.03.1993for 01 (one) year w.e.f. 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023 for operation of their unit subject to compliance of SEZ Act, 2005 &SEZ Rules, 2006.

**Agenda Item No.6: Request for renewal of LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/B-22/2006/2246 dated 12.07.2006 of M/s. Breconcherry Tankwash Systems, a manufacturing unit of Falta SEZ for renewal of LOP for a period of 05 (five) years.**

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve 01 (one) month temporary extension and requested the unit to submit 02 (two) year plan and to submit revised project plan so that the matter can be taken up to next UAC meeting for further course of action.
