Minutes of 148th meeting (7th meeting of the 2022 Series) of the Unit Approval Committee constituted in terms of Section 13 of Sub Section 1 of the Special Economic Zone Act, 2005 held on 25.07.2022 at 3.00 PM in the chamber of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone, 4th floor, 2nd MSO Building, Nizam Palace, 234/4, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata-700020 through Video Conferencing regarding Falta SEZ, Manikanchan SEZ, Kolkata IT Park SEZ, Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. IT/ITES SEZ, Wipro Ltd. IT/ ITES SEZ, DLF Ltd. IT/ITES SEZ & other SEZs in North Eastern States. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure-I.

Smt. Anindita Sen Gupta, Chairman & CEO welcomed all the members present in the meeting and requested Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy. Development Commissioner, Falta SEZ to place the agenda before the Committee for discussion.

Item wise decisions taken were as under:

Agenda Item No. A&B: Ratification of the minutes of 146th UAC meeting held on 27.06.2022.

Minutes of the 146th UAC was circulated to all the members of UAC. As no comments were received, the Committee ratified the minutes and confirmed the same.

Agenda Item No.1: Request of M/s. M.P. Industries, a unit in FSEZ for procurement of raw materials from DTA and by Import for manufacturing and export of "Umbrellas"-regarding

The request of M/s. M.P. Industries, a unit in FSEZ, for procurement of raw materials from DTA and by Import for manufacturing and export of "Umbrellas" has been discussed at length in detail by the Committee. No representative appeared before the Committee through Video Conferencing.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided that 100% Job Work for conversion of imported raw materials into components in the process of manufacture of "Umbrellas" cannot be approved at this stage. The unit may import or procure components from DTA, and manufacture/assemble the "Umbrellas" inside the Zone as per their LOP. Once the manufacture/ assembling of "Umbrellas" is in operation for at least 1(one) year, a part of production process may be considered for Job Work by the Specified Officer in terms of Rule 41 of SEZ Rules, 2006, depending upon the quantity and value of such production in the SEZ and export performance, NFE earning etc.

Further, the permission of Job Work to be considered by the Specified Officer subject to the fact that the unit is in a position to establish that goods after Job Work in DTA is sourced from the imported material when received back from DTA to SEZ.

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Agenda Item No.2: Request of M/s. Nipha Enterprises LLP, a unit in FSEZ for renewal of LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/N-21/2014/2468 dated 09.10.2014 for manufacturing of Parts of Agricultural Machinery, Parts & Assemblies for Tillage & Land Preparation Equipment – regarding

The request of M/s. Nipha Enterprises LLP, a unit in FSEZ, for renewal of LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/N-21/2014/2468 dated 09.10.2014, beyond 14.09.2022 for 5 (five) years for manufacturing of parts of Agricultural Machinery, parts & Assemblies for Tillage & Land Preparation Equipment was discussed and examined by the Committee. Shri Dipankar Halder represented on behalf of the unit through video conferencing for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to renew their LOP for a period of 5 (five) years beyond 14.09.2022. Moreover, the Committee also desired that the unit shall submit a plan for the next 5 (five) years as far as increase in proposed employment from 67 to 500 is concerned. The Committee also proposed for enhancement of female employment during the extended period of LOA.

Agenda Item No.3: Request of M/s. Prion Pvt. Ltd., a unit in FSEZ for temporary LOA for 30 days for final exit/ Debonding from FSEZ.

The request of M/s. Prion Pvt. Ltd., a unit in FSEZ for temporary LOA for 30 days for final exit/ De-bonding from FSEZ was discussed and examined by the Committee. The representative of the unit appeared before the Committee through video conferencing for consideration of their proposal.

The Committee noted that the LOP of the unit expired long time back i.e. on 27.06.2016. The unit submitted that due to various reasons, which were beyond their control, they could not start their production activity from their Unit in spite of their best intentions to do so. They wanted to discontinue from the Zone due to severe financial crunch and prayed for non-imposition of penalty.

In absence of valid LOA and DSC, the Unit could not file BOE in SEZ online. Thus, they have requested to issue a temporary extension of validity of LOA for filing of BOE through SEZ online for clearance of the 4 Nos. of CG in DTA by payment of Customs Duty.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to issue a temporary LOA for 30 (thirty) days, extendable upto 3 (three) months, if needed, for the specific purpose of De-bonding. The Committee further decided that imposition of penalty, if any, by adjudication of the SCN by the Adjudicating Authority may be processed in file.

Agenda Item No.4: Request for renewal of LOP NO. FSEZ/LIC/K-34-Unit-III/2005/2694 dated 01.08.2005 in respect of M/s. Kariwala Industries Ltd. (Unit-III) – regarding

The request for renewal of LOP NO. FSEZ/LIC/K-34-Unit-III/2005/2694 dated 01.08.2005 in respect of M/s. Kariwala Industries Ltd. (Unit-III) for a period of 5 (five) years beyond 30.06.2022 (2 months LOP extension already given in the 146th UAC held on 27.06.2022) was discussed and examined by the Committee. Mr. Anil Kariwala and CFO of the

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unit appeared before the Committee through video conferencing for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to renew the LOP beyond 5 (five) years beyond 30.06.2022 (2 months LOP extension already given in the 146th UAC held on 27.06.2022) and directed the unit for realization/regularization of the pending Foreign Exchange remittances at the earliest.

Agenda Item No.5: Proposal for inclusion of a new item in the existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/K-34-Unit-III/2005/2694 dated 01.08.2005 in respect of M/s. Kariwala Industries Ltd. (Unit-III)

The request of M/s.Kariwala Industries Ltd. (Unit-III), a unit in FSEZ, for inclusion of Item "Polyester/Cotton Woven Occupational Garment (Overall)" in their existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/K-34-Unit-III/2005/2694 dated 01.08.2005 was discussed in detail and thoroughly examined by the Committee. The Committee noted that ITC HSN Code given by the unit that comprised of 9 digits is not correct. The unit was requested to provide the corrected ITC HSN Code for the item.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve their proposal for inclusion of a new item "Polyester/Cotton Woven Occupational Garment (Overall)" in their existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/K-34-Unit-III/2005/2694 dated 01.08.2005 in respect of M/s. Kariwala Industries Ltd. (Unit-III).

Agenda Item No.6: Request for extension of validity period of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-22/1996/4445 dated 15.01.1997 by M/s. Precision Processors (India) Pvt. Ltd. for 3(three) months for De-bonding purpose - regarding

The request for extension of validity period of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/A-22/1996/4445 dated 15.01.1997 by M/s. Precision Processors (India) Pvt. Ltd. for 3(three) months for De-bonding purpose was discussed in detail by the Committee. The Committee noted that there is mismatch of data submitted by the unit for monitoring of APR and the NSDL data collected from FSEZ Customs. The unit was therefore requested to submit a clarification latest by Friday (29.07.2022) and a reconciliation of the data to be done by 4th of August.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to renew their LOA upto 30.09.2022 for specific de-bonding purpose. Fortnightly progress of their De-bonding is to be monitored. Necessary calculation of (-) NFE achieved by monitoring of the APR to be taken up in next UAC.

Agenda Item No.7: Application by M/s. Evique Jewels Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of a new Gem & Jewellery Manufacturing Unit at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone - Ratification of 146th UAC's directions

The Committee noted that as per 146th UAC's directions, all the physical documents submitted by M/s. Evique Jewels Pvt. Ltd. have been verified and found to be in order. The details of Kriti Gems and Rehan Jewels have also been verified from O/o DC, Surat SEZ vide their email dated 11.07.2022. Further, the unit has submitted an Undertaking dated 08.07.2022.

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that they will not be procuring gold on loan basis and they will be strictly adhering to the DOC's instructions No.D.12/4/2013-SEZ (Pt.) dated 18.09.2017.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the proposal of M/s. Evique Jewels Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of a new Gem & Jewellery Manufacturing Unit at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone.

Agenda Item No.8: Application of AML Rightsource India Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of a IT-ITES (Software Development and IT enabled Services) Unit at DLF, IT/ITES SEZ, New Town, Kolkata-700 156 - Ratification of 146th UAC's directions

The Committee noted that as per 146th UAC's directions, the unit has submitted all deficient documents and details of their scale of operations in Noida and Delhi. Further, the unit has submitted clarification on their Share Holding pattern, which states that their Foreign Share Holder holds 0.99 Lakhs, whereas the Indian Counterpart holds 0.01 Lakhs. The Committee also noted that a clarification has been sought by this office from DOC regarding guidelines on foreign share holder in the unit.

After due deliberation, the Committee has decided that the proposal of AML Rightsource India Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of an IT-ITES (Software Development and IT enabled Services) Unit at DLF, IT/ITES SEZ, New Town, Kolkata-700156, may be approved only after clarification is received from DOC.
