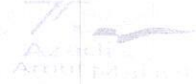

Subject: Minutes of the 192nd Unit Approval Committee (UAC) meeting (2nd meeting of the 2025 Series) held on 12.03.2025 at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone, Kolkata under the chairmanship of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone.

Agenda item no. 192.1: Ratification of the minutes of the 189th meeting of the Unit Approval Committee held on 8th January, 2025.

Minutes of 189th UAC meeting was circulated to all the members of the Committee. No comments were received from members.

Dy. Development Commissioner (AS), O/o DC, FSEZ stated that there was an error in the said UAC meeting agenda item no. 189.2(ii) i.e. "Request for approval of default list of services for authorized operations at Falta SEZ by M/s Krypton Industries Ltd". **Customs Wing, FSEZ vide the Inter Section Note dated 21.11.2024 had actually confirmed procurement of 'Cargo Handling' services [sl. no. 8 of the DoC approved list] by the unit at Falta SEZ,** but in 2nd paragraph and 3rd paragraph (sl. no. 14) of the agenda it got erroneously mentioned as 'Management, Maintenance or repair' services [sl. no. 33 of the DoC approved list] and accordingly the minutes was issued.

Minutes of agenda item no. 189.2(ii) was therefore corrected and ratified by the Committee as under:

"Shri Digvijay S.Bardia physically represented the unit before the Committee. The unit has requested for approving 15 (fifteen) services as their default services.

Committee considered the matter by referring to the list of default services for SEZ units, as approved by SEZ Section, Department of Commerce,



Customs Wing, Falta SEZ vide Inter Section Note dated 21.11.2024 has confirmed that the unit has given documentary evidence towards procurement of only 'Cargo Handling' services at Falta SEZ.

Committee, therefore, approved only 'Cargo Handling' service [Sl. No. 8 of the DoC approved list] as default services i.r.o. the unit."

Committee also ratified rest of the minutes of the 189th UAC meeting.

Agenda item no.192.2 (i) : Request for approval of "Default list of Services" for authorized operation at Falta SEZ by M/s Nipha Enterprises LLP.

Shri Babla Sen physically represented the unit before the Committee.

Committee considered the matter by referring to the list of default services for SEZ units, as approved by SEZ Section, Department of Commerce.

Customs Wing, O/o DC, Falta SEZ vide Inter Section Note dated 24.01.2025 has confirmed, based on documentary evidences, that the said 34 services have been procured by the unit at Falta SEZ.

Committee, therefore, approved the 34 (thirty four) services as default services i.r.o. the unit as listed under:

Agenda item no.192.2 (ii) : Request for inclusion of additional items 'Photovoltaic DC Generators >50W with Blocking and Bypass Diode viz. HS Code No.85017200 in the existing LOP No.2(1)/D-101200518606 dated 04.03.2005 of M/s Websol Energy System Limited, Falta SEZ, in addition to the existing items of manufacture and export.

Shri Saswata Majumdar, General Manager (Business Development) and Shri Modaswar Hossain, Senior Manager physically represented the unit before the Committee. Unit stated before Committee that the subject item has very good demand in the export market and its inclusion in the Letter of Approval would result in significant increase in their exports. Unit therefore requested for inclusion of the said item in their Letter of Approval.

Committee considered the matter in terms of 1st proviso of Rule 19(2) and Rule 26 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006.

It was observed that the proposed item namely 'Photovoltaic DC Generators >50W with Blocking and Bypass Diode' having ITC (HS) code 85017200 is a freely exportable item as per Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export and Import items. It was further observed that there will be additional investment by the unit to the tune of Rs 20-25 crores if the item gets allowed for export.

Committee, therefore, approved inclusion of the subject item in Letter of Approval of the unit.

Agenda item no.192.3 (i) : Request application for setting up of a new Gems and Jewellery manufacturing Unit at Manikanchan SEZ.

Shri Bijay Maji, Director physically represented the applicant M/s Gaurangi Jewellers Private Limited before the Committee.

Committee considered the matter in terms of Rule 18 and Rule 26 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006. Following were observed:



- i. That the proposed items of export namely Handmade/Machine made plain gold jewellery [ITC(HS) code: 71131911], Handmade / Machine made Gold Jewellery studded with pearl [ITC(HS) code : 71131912], Handmade/ Machine made Gold Jewellery studded with diamonds [ITC(HS) code : 71131913] and Handmade/ Machine made Gold Jewellery studded with other precious and semi-precious stones [ITC(HS) code : 71131915] are freely exportable items as per Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export and Import items.
- ii. That M/s West Bengal Industrial Development Corporation (WBIDC), developer of Manikanchan Special Economic Zone (MKSEZ), vide letter dated 21.02.2025 has confirmed availability of space /module for the applicant in MKSEZ.
- iii. That the proposal envisages positive Net Foreign Exchange earning in 5 years (amounting around Rs 19.11 crores), investment of Rs 16.00 lakhs in capital goods and employment generation for 28 people (with 3 women).

Committee, therefore, approved request of the applicant for setting up gems & jewellery manufacturing unit at MKSEZ.

Agenda item no.192.4 (i) : Intimation about the change of designation of Mr. Amit Jain from Additional Director to Directors to M/s. Candor Kolkata One Hi-Tech Structures Pvt Ltd w.e.f 30/09/2024.

No one represented the subject Special Economic Zone developer before the Committee.

Committee noted the intimation in terms of Instruction no. 109 dated 18.10.2021 of Department of Commerce.
