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Subject: Minutes of the 194th Unit Approval Committee (UAC) meeting (3rd meeting of the 2025 Series) held on 30.04.2025 at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone, Kolkata under the chairmanship of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone.

Agenda item no. 194.1: Ratification of the minutes of the 192nd meeting of the Unit Approval Committee held on 12th March, 2025.

Minutes of 192nd UAC meeting was circulated to all the Committee members. As no comments received from members, the present Committee ratified the minutes.

Agenda item no.194.2 (i): Application by M/s West Bengal Warehousing and Trading Co. for setting up of a new manufacturing unit at Falta SEZ.

Shri Kadri Parvez Husenmiya, Proprietor physically represented the company before the Committee. The company requested for manufacturing and export of following items from Falta SEZ:

Committee considered the matter in terms of Rule 18 and Rule 26 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006. Following were observed:

- i. That all the items are free for export as per the schedule 2 (export policy) of Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export items.
- ii. That the inputs/raw materials for the items of manufacture are sensitive in nature.
- iii. That the proposal envisages positive Net Foreign Exchange (NFE) earning in 5 years (amounting Rs 1250.00 lakhs), investment of Rs 20.00 lakhs in plant and machinery and employment opportunity for 25 people.
- iv. That the company vide letter dated 14.02.2025 has undertaken that they will adhere to all the environmental and pollution control norms while manufacturing the said items in Falta SEZ.

Committee approved the proposal, with the condition that the company has to submit Standard Input Output Norms (SION) i.r.o. their said items of export and the Letter of Approval (LoA) to be issued by O/o DC, Falta SEZ only after receipt of the SION.

Agenda item no.194.2 (ii): Application by M/s Bitumix India LLP for setting up a new trading unit at Falta SEZ.

Shri Gaurav Agarwal, Partner virtually represented the company before the Committee. The company requested for trading of following item from Falta SEZ:

It was clarified by the company before the committee that the trading will be done by importing the item and then re-exporting it.

- i. That the item is free for export as per the schedule 2 (export policy) of Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export items.
- ii. That the proposal envisages positive NFE earning in 5 years (amounting Rs 410.00 lakhs), nil investment in plant & machinery (being trading unit) and employment opportunity for 4 people.

Committee approved the proposal.
