Subject: Implementation of Electronic Sealing (E-Sealing) of Export Containers & other movements under self-sealing procedure at Falta Special Economic Zone (FSEZ)-reg

Attention of all Units, Clients, Importers, Exporters, Customs Brokers, Shipping Lines / Shipping Agents and all other concerned is invited to Rule 46(1) of SEZ Rules, 2006, Instruction No.124 dated 22.07.2026 vide F.No.K-43022/182/2025-SEZ-Part(1) issued by the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of Commerce(SEZ Section) and Circular No. 26/2017-Cus dated 01.07.2017, Circular No.36/2017-Customs dated 28.08.2017 and Circular No.41/2017-Customs dated 30.10.2017 issued by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs(CBIC), Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance.

2. As per Clause (c) of Rule 46 of SEZ Rules, 2006

Rule 46: Procedure for export - (1) The procedure for export from Special Economic Zone through seaports or airports or Inland Container Depot or Container Freight Station or Land Custom Station or by Post or by Courier or by Personal Carriage, as the case may be, shall be as under:-

(c) the goods shall not be subjected to routine examination and "Let

Export Order" shall be given on the basis of self-certification by the Unit.

Explanation - " Self Certification " means the certification regarding sealing of containers or package of goods under export by the units and includes the certificate regarding contents and sealing of the container or package given by the owner or the working partner or the managing Director or the Company Secretary of the unit or any person authorized in this behalf by the owner or company or working partner, as the case may be on the copies of Shipping Bill stating that the package or container in respect of good under export have been sealed in his presence;

3. As per Point No.3 of the Instruction No. 124 dated 22.07.2026 vide F.No.K-43022/182/2025-SEZ-Part(1) issued by the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of Commerce(SEZ Section):

It is hereby directed to use only RFID seal on SEZ export containers covered under valid LEOs, in terms of CBIC Circular No.41/2017-Cus. dated 30.10.2017, without insistence on additional sealing requirements for uniform acceptance at all gateway ports.

4. As per para 9, point vii. of the Circular No.26/2017-Customs dated 01.07.2017:

It has been decided to do away with the sealing of containers with export goods by CBIC officials. Instead, self-sealing procedure shall be followed subject to the following:

vii. The exporter shall seal the container with tamper proof electronic seal of standard specification. The electronic seal should have a unique number which should be declared in the Shipping Bill. Before sealing the container, the exporter shall feed the data such as name of the exporter, IEC code, GSTIN number, description of the goods, tax invoice number, name of the authorized signatory (for affixing the seal) and Shipping Bill number in the electronic seal. Thereafter, container shall be sealed with the same electronic seal before leaving the premises.

5. As per Circular No.36/2017-Customs dated 01.07.2017:

Para 2(e): Exporters shall directly procure RFID seals from vendors,

conforming to the standard specification mentioned in para 3 of the said Circular. Since the procedure seeks to enhance integrity of transportation of goods, the exporters will be required to obtain seals directly. They shall provide details such as IEC etc., at the time of purchase for identification as well as for using the standard web application necessary to support an RFID self-sealing ecosystem.

Para 3(a): The electronic seal referred to in Para 9 (vii) of the Circular No.26/2017-Customs dated 01.07.2017 shall be an "RFID tamper proof one-time bolt seal", each bearing a unique serial number. The exporters shall be responsible for procuring the seal at their own cost for use in self sealing.

6. In view of the above specific provisions in SEZ Rules, 2006 and CBIC Circulars, it has been decided that self-sealing of containers or packages goods under export will be done by the respective unit itself. Certificate regarding contents and sealing of the container or package given by the owner or the working partner or the managing Director or the company, any authorised officer by the Unit or any person authorized in this behalf by the owner of the company or working partner, as the case may be, on the copies of shipping bill stating that the package or container in respect of goods under export have been sealed in his presence shall be produced before Authorised Officer for Let Export Order (LEO).

7. In view of CBIC Circular No.26/2017 dated 01.07.2017, Circular No.36/2017 dated 28.08.2017 & Circular No.41/2017 dated 30.10.2017, It has been decided to implement Electronic Sealing Procedure in case of the Containerized export cargo. All the containers containing export goods shall be self-sealed by the Unit with RFID based tamper-proof one-time bolt seal each bearing a Unique serial No.

8. Attention is also invited to Rule 75 of SEZ Rules, 2006 which states:

Rule 75 Self-Declaration- Unless otherwise specified in these rules all inward or outward movement of goods into or from the Zone by the Unit or Developer shall be based on self-declaration made and no routine examination of these goods shall be made unless specific orders of the Development Commissioner or the Specific Officer are obtained.

9. Accordingly, it has been decided that outward movements of the

cargo such as SEZ to EOU, SEZ to Bonded Warehouse and Zone to Zone transfers shall be based on Self-declaration under self-sealing by the Unit under RFID based tamper-proof one-time bolt seal each bearing a unique serial number.

10. The new self-sealing procedure shall come into effect from 01.08.2026. Till then the existing procedure shall continue.
