**Sub: Minutes of the 128<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Unit Approval Committee (UAC) held on 11.05.2021**

The 128<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Unit Approval Committee (3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the 2021 Series) Constituted in terms of Section 13 of Sub Section 1 of the Special Economic Zone Act, 2005 held on 11.05.2021 at 3.30 PM in the chamber of Development Commissioner, Falra Special Economic Zone, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, 2<sup>nd</sup> MSO Building, Nizam Palace, 234/4, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata-700020 through Video Conferencing on the issues relating to Falra SEZ, Manikanchan SEZ, Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech IT/ IteS SEZ, TCS IT/ITES SEZ and DLF IT/ITeS SEZs.

Dr. B.K. Panda, Chairman & CEO of the Committee welcomed all the Members present in the meeting and requested Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy.Development Commissioner, Falra SEZ to place the agenda before the Committee for discussion. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure-I.

**Item wise decisions held were as under:**

**Agenda Item No. A&B: Ratification of the Minutes of 127<sup>th</sup> UAC meeting held on 19.03.2021**

Minutes of the 127<sup>th</sup> UAC meeting was circulated to all the Members of UAC. No comments were received from the Members; hence the Committee ratified the Minutes and confirmed the same.

**Agenda Item No.1: Application of M/s. Indi Rise Enterprise for setting up of a new manufacturing and trading Unit at Falra SEZ, Falra.**

The request of M/s. Indi Rise Enterprise for setting up of a new manufacturing and trading Unit at Falra SEZ, Falra was discussed in detail by the Committee and examined. Shri Goura Chandra Dash represented on behalf of the Unit through video conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. He also confirmed about submission of two applications; one for manufacturing and another for trading.

The Committee noted that two separate applications with two project reports have been submitted by the Unit, one for manufacturing of Magnesia Chrome Bricks (HS Code- 69021020) and one for trading of Chrome Monolithics (HS Code – 69039040). The Committee also noted that the earlier deficient documents have now been submitted by the Proprietor of the firm.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the request of the firm for setting up of a new manufacturing and a new trading Unit on the basis of their applications in Form F, their project profile subject to the following conditions and compliance of SEZ Act, 2005 & SEZ Rules,2006: -

- i. Separate LOPs to be issued for manufacturing and trading Units. The Unit shall clearly demarcate the areas for manufacturing and trading and maintain separate accounts of each Unit. It is clarified that 'trading' implies import for export purposes, not for DTA Sale.
- ii. The Unit shall submit the ITC – HS Code of the Imported/ Indigenous raw materials required in their manufacturing process of Magnesia Chrome Bricks (HS Code-69021020).

**Agenda Item No.2: Request for renewal of LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/H-19/2011/2633 dated 14.09.2011 of M/s. Hi tech information & Marketing Pvt. Ltd., an Unit in FSEZ, beyond 14.12.2020.**

The request for renewal of LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/H-19/2011/2633 dated 14.09.2011 of M/s. Hi tech information & Marketing Pvt.Ltd. beyond 14.12.2020 for a period of (5) five years was discussed and examined in detail. Shri Biswajit Roy, Factory Manager of the Unit represented on behalf of the Unit through video conference and presented their request for consideration. After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the same subject to submission of a clarification by the Unit whether any Foreign Exchange Outgo will be there in the next five years.

**Agenda Item No.3: Request for extension of validity period of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/D-20/2005/7171 dated 07.01.2005 by M/s. Delta Plus (India) Pvt. Ltd., an unit in FSEZ, beyond 31.05.2021**

The requested for extension of validity period of LOA No. FEPZ/LIC/D-20/2005/7171 dated 07.01.2005 by M/s. Delta Plus (India) Pvt Ltd. beyond 30.05.2021 for a period of five years was examined in detail by the Committee. Smt. Dhara Agarwal on behalf of the Unit represented their request before the Committee through video conference. The Committee also noted that the Unit has not submitted the application for extension of LOP in time due to some technical problem for which the Unit apologized.

After deliberation, the Committee accepted the apology of the Unit and decided to extend the LOP for a period of five years w.e.f. 31.05.2021 to 30.05.2026.

**Agenda Item No.4: Request for addition of new Item in the existing LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/N-21/2014/2468 dated 09.10.2014 of M/s. Nipha Enterprise LLP, an unit in Falta SEZ.**

The request for addition of new Item in their existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/N-21/2014/2468 dt. 09.10.2014 of M/s. Nipha Enterprises LLP have been discussed in detail. Shri Dipankar Halder represented on the behalf of the Unit through VC and explained their request for consideration. The Committee noted the new Item-Flat Materials & Rolled Sheet (HSN code – 72288090) is analogous to the generic Items already included in their LOP and they desired this item to be included in their LOP as per the demand of their foreign customer.

After deliberation, the Committee decided to approve for incorporation of new Item in the existing LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/N-21/2014/2468 dated 09.10.2014 for Flat Materials & Rolled Sheet (HSN code -72288090), subject to compliance of SEZ Rules 2006, as applied by the Unit.

**Agenda Item No.5: Application of M/s. Avolakan Tradelinks Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of a new trading Unit at Falta SEZ, Falta.**

The request for setting up of a new trading Unit at Falta SEZ of M/s. Avolakan Tradelinks Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of a new Trading Unit at Falta SEZ, Falta was discussed in detail and examined. Shri Poojan Desai represented on behalf of the Unit through video conference and explained their request for consideration. The Committee asked the Unit to clarify the specific ITC HS Code, for which they have applied. The Unit clarified the same. The Unit was also requested by the Committee to clarify for low employment rate. The Unit clarified that it will increase in due course of time.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve for setting up of a new Trading Unit at Falta SEZ on the basis of their application in Form F, project profile and subject to submission of specific ITC HS Code and submission of application through SEZ online.

**Agenda Item No.6: Non-performance of M/s. SCG Exports Pvt. Ltd., an Unit in Manikanchan SEZ and non-utilization of the space by the Unit allotted by WBIDC.**

The Committee noted the non-performance of M/s. SCG Exports Pvt. Ltd. from 2017-18 and non-utilization of the space allotted by the Developer, WBIDC. The Committee noted that the LOP of the Unit expired on 07.02.2018 and the Unit had not applied for renewal of the same till date. The Unit was also asked for clarification for non-performance for FY 2017-18 but no response had been received till date. The Committee also noted that the Unit had stopped

manufacturing since long time. After due deliberation, the Committee, decided to issue SCN to the Unit for non-performance and non-utilization of the space.

**Agenda Item No.7: Request for M/s. Indorama Ventures Global Shares Services Pvt Ltd., an unit in Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. SEZ for approval of 59 nos. of default authorized services.**

The request of M/s. Indorama Ventures Global Shares Services Pvt. Ltd for approval of 59 nos. of default authorized services was discussed at length. ShriHimanshuDeopaappeared on behalf of the Unit and explained their request for consideration of their proposal before the Committee through video conference.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the default list of services for consumption in their Unit as per Annexure in terms of MOC letter No. D.12/19/2013-SEZ dated 02.01.2018 and Instruction No.94 dated 08.05.2019 for authorized operation for exemption of service tax, except those services at Sl. No. 38 of their Annexure i.e. "Site formation, and clearing, excavation and earth moving" in the list of default authorized services.

**Agenda Item No.8: Request of M/s. Simplify Workforce Technologies Pvt. Ltd., an unit in Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. SEZ for approval of 59 default authorized services.**

The request of M/s. Simply Workforce Technologies Pvt. Ltd. for approval of 59 nos. of default authorized services was discussed at length. Shri Dhruva Kumar Chakraborty, authorized representative on behalf of the Unit appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their request for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the 59 Nos. of default list of services, as requested by the Unit for consumption in their Unit as per Annexure in terms of MOC letter No. D.12/19/2013-SEZ dated 02.01.2018 and Instruction No.94 dated 08.05.2019 for authorized operations for exemption of service tax.

**Agenda Item No.9: Request for Capgemini Technologies Services Ltd., an unit in Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. SEZ for procurement of drone camera for soft ware and testing proposes.**

The request of M/s. Capgemini Technologies Services Ltd. for procurement of drone camera for software and testing proposes was discussed in detail and examined by the Committee. Shri Ramakrishna Menon, authorized representative on behalf of the Unit appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their request for consideration of

their proposal. The Committee noted that the Unit has declared that Drone Camera is for testing and software development purpose only and not for sale or any other commercial activities.

Further, the Committee also noted about submission of a joint Inspection Report by the Committee comprising of Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy. Development Commissioner and Shri Ramkrishna Menon & Jayanti Mullick, both officials of the unit on the above said procurement. After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the same as requested by the Unit.

**Agenda Item No.10: Request of M/s. Codeclouds IT Solutions Pvt. Ltd., an unit in Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. SEZ, for approval of 59 Nos. of default authorized services.**

The request of M/s. Codeclouds IT Solutions Pvt. Ltd. for approval of 59 nos. of default authorized services was discussed at length. Shri P. Saha, authorized person on behalf of the Unit appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their request for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the 59 Nos. of default list of services, as requested by the Unit for consumption in their Unit as per Annexure, in terms of MOC letter No. D.12/19/2013-SEZ dated 02.01.2018 and Instruction No.94 dated 08.05.2019 for authorized operations for exemption of service tax.

**Agenda Item No.11: Request of M/s. Candor Kolkata One-Hitech Structures Pvt. Ltd., Developer of Candor IT/ ITES SEZ, for approval of 14 nos. of default authorized services.**

The request of M/s. Candor Kolkata One-Hitech Structures Pvt. Ltd., Developer of Candor IT/ ITES SEZ, for approval of 14 nos. of default authorized services for authorized operation was discussed in detail and examined by the Committee. Shri Shibaji Chatterjee, the authorized representative of the Developer, appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their request. The Committee took note of the letter No.10/108/2007-SEZ/2941 dated 26.03.2021 issued by the O/o Development Commissioner, Noida SEZ, where the 14 Nos. of services had been approved by their UAC for Candor Gurgaon One Realty Projects Pvt. Ltd., the Developer of IT/ ITES SEZ at Village Tikri, Sector-48, Gurugram (Haryana) under the jurisdiction of Noida SEZ.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve the same 14 Nos. of list of services, as requested by the Unit for consumption in the zone, as per Annexure, subject to compliance of the DOC Instruction No.79 dated 19.11.2013 and Instruction No.94 dated 08.05.2019 for authorized operations for exemption of service tax.

The request for extension of validity period of LOA No. DLF SEZ/LIC/E-1/2011/535 dated 16.05.2011 by M/s. Ericsson India Global Services Pvt. Ltd., an Unit in DLF IT/ ITeS SEZ beyond 19.06.2021 was examined and discussed in detail by the Committee. Shri Ashish Naskar authorized representative, represented on behalf of the Unit before the Committee through video conference for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to extend the LOP for five years w.e.f. 20.06.2021.

The request for extension of validity period of LOA No. FSEZ/LIC/I-23/2003/6044 dated 01.10.2003 by M/s. Indo-Tossa Pvt. Ltd., beyond 31.05.2021 was examined and discussed in detail by the Committee. Shri SashankSanghanaria, Director, represented on behalf of the Unit before the Committee through video conference for consideration of their proposal.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to extend the LOP for five years beyond 31.05.2021.

The request for setting up of a new manufacturing Unit at Falta SEZ of M/s. Ione Exim for setting up of a new manufacturing Unit at Falta SEZ, Falta was discussed in detail and examined. Shri Gaurav Kirpal, the Proprietor, appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their request for consideration. The Committee enquired the Unit about FSSAI certification as they have applied for manufacturing of Dry Fruits. The Unit confirmed about the possession of FSSAI's NOC.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve for setting up of a new manufacturing Unit at Falta SEZ on the basis of their application in Form F, project profile and subject to submission of:-

- i. the details of the manufacturing process {as per Rule 2(r) of the SEZ Act, 2005} for the finished product and the specific ITC – HS Codes of the raw materials to be used in the manufacturing process. It is obligatory that the manufacturing activity of the Unit shall cater to the definition of 'manufacture' under Section 2 (r) of SEZ Act, 2005.

**Agenda Item No.17: Proposal for inclusion of new items in the existing LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/I-31/2020/3278 dated 17.02.2021 in respect of M/s. Ione Exim, a trading unit in Falta SEZ**

The request for inclusion of new Items in the existing LOP No. FSEZ/LIC/I-31/2020/3278 dated 17.02.2021 of M/s. Ione Exim, an unit in Falta SEZ was examined and discussed in detail by the Committee. Shri Gaurav Kirpal, Proprietor of the firm, represented on behalf of the Unit, appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their proposal for consideration.

After deliberation, the Committee approved the same for inclusion of new Item "Spices-0910 & Garments-6201" in their existing LOA FSEZ/LIC/I-31/2020/3278 dated 17.02.2021 of M/s. Ione Exim, as applied by the Unit, subject to the Unit submitting the specific 8-digit ITC-HS Code of the new Items. It is clarified that 'trading' implies import for export purposes, not for DTA Sale. The Committee also observed that if any manufacturing process is involved in the new Items like 'grinding' or processing otherwise, then the unit may apply for inclusion of the item in Manufacturing LOP, later on, for consideration of the UAC.

**Agenda Item No.18: Permission for DTA Sale by M/s. Ione Exim, a trading Unit in Falta SEZ**

The request of M/s. Ione Exim, a trading Unit in Falta SEZ, holding LOP No.FSEZ/LIC/I-31/2020/3278 dated 17.02.2021, for permission for DTA Sale of 4 consignments of Dry Fruits (perishable Goods) at FSEZ, was examined and discussed in detail by the Committee.

Shri Gaurav Kirpal, Proprietor of the firm, represented on behalf of the Unit, before the Committee through video conference and explained their proposal for consideration. The Committee noted that being a new Unit, to cope with the current pandemic COVID-19 situation and to meet up the operational costs, they have requested for such DTA sale permission.

After detailed deliberation, the Committee considered their request for DTA sale of 4 consignments of Dry Fruits as one-time relaxation measure only, on the backdrop of this COVID-19 situation all over the world, subject to the condition that the DTA sale by the trading Unit shall be subject to achievement of positive NFE cumulatively on their part and payment of applicable taxes/ duties of Customs.

**Agenda Item No.19: Request for approval for Telecommunication Service by installation of Telecom Equipment by Summit Digital Infrastructure, M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd. and M/s. Vodafone Idea Ltd for seamless connectivity inside TCS Rajarhat IT/ ITeS SEZ.**

The request of Tata Consultancy Services Ltd., Developer of TCS Rajarhat IT/ItES SEZ for installation of Telecom equipments by M/s. Summit Digital Infrastructure, M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd. and M/s. Vodafone Ideal in their SEZ campus was discussed and examined in detail by the Committee. The authorized representative, represented on behalf of the Unit, appeared before the Committee through video conference and explained their proposal for consideration. The Committee noted that the request of the Developer is to get better connectivity within the SEZ campus and the said service is restricted to their TCS Rajarhat IT/ ItES SEZ area only. The Committee also noted the they will submit MOUs signed with the Service Providers to this office.

No.51 of default authorized services, in terms of Instruction No.79 dated 19.11.2013, subject to that services to be made available by the Service Providers through the said equipments shall be restricted to be utilized in the SEZ only. In this context, the Developer would submit MOU signed with the Service Providers clearly mentioning therein that all the services through the said equipments shall be utilized in the SEZ only.
