Minutes of 136<sup>th</sup> meeting(8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the 2021 Series) of the Unit Approval Committee Constituted in terms of Section 13 of Sub Section 1 of the Special Economic Zone Act, 2005 held on08.11.2021 at 3.30 PM in the chamber of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, 2<sup>nd</sup> MSO Building, Nizam Palace, 234/4, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata-700 020 through Video Conferencing regarding Falta SEZ, Candor Kolkata, Wipro IT/ ITES SEZ and DLF IT/ITES SEZs. List of participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

Dr. B.K. Panda, Chairman & CEO welcomed all the members present in the meeting and requested Shri M.K. Anjanaiah, Dy. DC, Falta SEZ to place the agenda before the Committee for discussion.

#### Item wise decisions taken were as under:

Agenda Item No. A&B: Ratification of the minutes of 134th UAC meeting held on 29.09.2021.

Minutes of the 134<sup>th</sup>UAC meeting was circulated to all the members of UAC. As no comments were received, the committee ratified the minutes and confirmed the same.

## Agenda Item No.1: Application of M/s. CrixcruzeImpex Private Limited for setting up of a Trading unit at Fata Special Zone-regarding.

The request of M/s. CrixcruzeImpex Private Limited for setting up of a new Trading unit at Falta SEZ was discussed at length and thoroughly examined by the Committee. ShriIndrajit Shaw appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The Committee inquired about their plan for carrying out their business activity in Falta Zone, which was clarified on behalf of the company during the course of discussion. The Unit was apprised by the Committee that no DTA sale would be allowed and Imports would be allowed only for Exports purpose. The Committee also enquired about the Value Addition they would do and they agreed they would be complying to Value Addition norms.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve their proposal for setting up of a new unit(Trading) for running their authorized operation at Falta SEZ based on their application in Form F along with projectprofile as submitted by the unit in terms of provision in Rule 18 of SEZ Rules, 2006.

#### Agenda Item No.2: Application of M/s. Cloom Trading Private Limited for Setting up of Trading Unit at Falta Special Economic Zone.

The request of M/s. Cloom Trading Private Limited for setting up of a new Trading unit at Falta SEZ was discussed at length and thoroughly examined by the Committee. ShriMukesh Kumar Verma appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing

during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The committee inquired about their Item of Perfumes [ITC(HS) Code 33030100] which falls under Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. The Committee requested the concerned unit for getting necessary registration with Assistant Drugs Controller, Central Drugs Standard Control Organization, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and any other formalities with them before inclusion in the LOP of this item, i.e. perfumes(ITC code 33030100). The Unit was apprised by the Committee that no DTA sale would be allowed and Imports would be allowed only for Exports purpose. The Committee also enquired about the Value Addition they would do and they agreed they would be complying to Value Addition norms.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve their proposal for setting up of a new unit(Trading) for running authorized operation at Falta SEZ on above terms based on their application from F along with project profile as submitted by the firm in terms of provision in Rule 18 of SEZ Rules, 2006.

#### Agenda Item No.3: Application of M/s. Patton International Limited for setting up of another manufacturing unit in Falta SEZ

The request of M/s. Patton International Limited for setting up of another SEZ unit at Falta SEZ was noted and examined by the Committee. ShriSumitGoel appeared before the Committee on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The committee noted M/s. Patton International Ltd. have one operational unit in Falta SEZ.

The Committee apprised the unit that the ITC (HSN) Code for Import, Cold Rolled Sheet in Coil i.e. 72091620 contains 2-3 types of items. Thus, the unit is requested to specify the exact details of the ITC (HSN) Code for Imports alongwith the thickness of the iron/steel/Electric Sheet. The Unit was further apprised by the Committee that for any addition of items in their LOP or new LOP manufacturing process to be submitted to PCB for obtaining PCB clearances. they would have to take NOC/ permissions for WBPCB.

After due deliberation, the Committee decided to approve their proposal for setting up of another new manufacturing unit at Falta SEZ based on their application in Form F along with project profile as submitted by the firm in terms of provision in Rule 18 of SEZ Rules, 2006 subject to above clarification at para 2 mentioned

The request for renewal of LOA No.FEPZ/LIC/M-1/2016/140 dated 07.04.2016 in respect of M/s. Met Technologies Pvt. Ltd. at Candor Kolkata One Hi-Tech Structures Pvt. Ltd. IT/ITES SEZ, Infospace, Rajarhat New Town, Action Area 1-D, Kolkata-700156, West Bengal, Indiawas discussed and examined in detail by the Committee. Mr.SouravDagarepresented on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. from 2016-17 to 2019-20 and has achieved (+NFE) and no realization is pending. The Unit also stated that they are expecting a FOB value of Exports of Rs.7.00 Crores in FY 2021-22.

After deliberation, the committee decided to renew the LoA No. FEPZ/LIC/M-1/2016/140 dated 07.04.2016 w.e.f. **30.11.2021 to 29.11.2026** i.e.for another five year beyond the expiry of their LoA as applied by the unit subject to condition of strict compliance of SEZ Rules & Act, 2005.

#### Agenda Item No.5: Enhancement of Bond-cum-LUT value by M/s. Capgemini Technology Services India Ltd., an unit in Candor Kolkata One Hi-tech Structures SEZ.

The request of M/s. Capgemini Technology Services India Ltd. an unit in Candor One Hi-Tech Structures SEZ has requested for permission of enhancement of Bond-cum-LUT forRs. 3000 Lakhs in INR due to exhaustion of existing B-LUT bond value was examined.ShriRakrishnaMenon represented on behalf of the unit through Video Conferencing during the course of discussion in the UAC and requested their proposal for consideration. The Committee noted that the unit has been permitted by the UAC for refurbishing and refurnishing of their unit of around 1,82,400Sq.ft. area.
