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Subject: Minutes of the 183<sup>rd</sup> Unit Approval Committee (UAC) meeting (10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the 2024 Series) held on 25.09.2024 at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone, Kolkata under the chairmanship of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone.

Agenda item no. 183.1: Ratification of the minutes of the 182<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Unit Approval Committee held on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.

Minutes of 182<sup>nd</sup> UAC meeting was circulated to all the members of the Committee. As no comments were received from members, the Committee ratified the minutes.

Agenda item no.183.2 (i): Request for approval of List of Services for authorized operation at Falta SEZ by M/s.DRK Metallurgical Pvt Ltd

Shri Indrajit Basak physically represented the unit before the Committee.

Committee considered the matter in light of the instructions issued by SEZ Division, Department of Commerce in this regard.

It was observed, that Specified Officer, O/o DC Falta SEZ vide Inter Section Note dated 28.08.2024 has confirmed that the requested 18 (eighteen) services viz. Customs House agent services, Port services, Clearing & forwarding agents services, General insurance and business services, Legal consultancy services, Chattered Accountant services, Company Secretary Services, Cost Accountant services, Manpower Recruitment and supply agency services, Scientific or technical consultancy services, Goods Transport agency services, Courier services, Cargo Handling services, Other Port

services, Technical inspection and certification services, Technical Testing and Analysis services and SEZ online services are getting availed by the unit in Falta SEZ.

Committee, therefore, approved the said 18 services as default authorized services i.r.o. the unit.

# Agenda No.183.2 (ii): Request of M/s Indi Rise Enterprises LLP, a unit of Falta SEZ, for change in their item of manufacture.

Shri Manoj Kumar Das virtually represented the unit before the Committee.

It was observed, that the unit has proposed to manufacture 'Cr Foundry Sand' bearing ITC (HS) code no. 26100090, instead of 'Foundry Sand'. And said ITC (HS) code comes under the sub head 'Chromium Ores and Concentrates' of Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export and Import Items, and is a restricted item of export.

Committee, therefore, after deliberation approved the proposed change of item in the Letter of Approval of the unit, with the condition that the said item will be subjected to the export policy as per the Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export and Import Items.

# Agenda No.183.2 (iii)/Sup-1: Renewal of LOA of M/s Enfield Solar Energy Ltd.

Shri Harish Singh virtually represented the unit before the Committee.

### Following were observed:

- i. That, the unit was awarded two Letters of Approval (LoA), one dated 26.02.2010 and the other dated 09.09.2010.
- ii. That, Date of Commencement of Production (DCP) i.r.o. the LoA dated 26.02.2010 was declared as 28.09.2011, and it got expired on 28.09.2021. And i.r.o. the other LoA dated 09.09.2010, DCP not declared and accordingly it got deemed lapsed on 08.09.2011 as per provision of SEZ Rules, 2006.
- That, the unit went into Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP) vide order dated 27.06.2019 of Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Kolkata Bench (NCLT). And due to absence of a Resolution Plan during the course of CIRP, Hon'ble NCLT vide order dated 10.01.2020 passed order for Liquidation of the unit (Corporate Debtor).
- That, M/s Thakur Prasad Sao & Sons Private Limited was the highest bidder in the auction, and accordingly the Liquidator vide Sale Certificate dated 23.08.2021 sold the unit (Corporate Debtor) to M/s Thakur Prasad Sao & Sons Private Limited as a 'Going Concern', and the said sale was approved by Hon'ble NCLT vide order dated 22.10.2021.

Committee, therefore, after deliberation approved renewal of the unit's LoA dated 26.02.2010 w.e.f. from its date of expiry in compliance to the order of Hon'ble NCLT.

# Agenda No.183.3 (i): Application of M/s MOHIT Jewellers for setting up of a new Gems& Jewellery manufacturing Unit at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone

Shri Mohit Agarwal physically represented the unit before the Committee.

Committee considered the matter in light of Rule 18 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006.

It was observed, that the proposed 4 (four) gems & jewelry items are freely exportable as per the Indian Trade Classification (Harmonized System) of Export and Import Items. The said items are as under:

And it was further observed, that developer of Manikanchan SEZ M/s West Bengal Industrial Development Corporation (a Government of West Bengal undertaking) vide letter no. WBIDC/IP/MK/SDF(1-NE)/2024/1133 dated 20/09/2024 has confirmed availability of space in the SEZ for the company.

Committee, therefore, approved the subject proposal, and noted the projected FOREX balance sheet for five years (Rs 1400.94 crores export with Net Foreign Exchange earning of Rs 49.98 crores), proposed investment of Rs 18 lakhs in plant & machinery and proposed employment of 49 people (with 4 women).
