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Subject: Minutes of the 197th Unit Approval Committee (UAC) meeting (6th meeting of the 2025 Series) held on 23.07.2025 at Manikanchan Special Economic Zone, Kolkata under the chairmanship of Development Commissioner, Falta Special Economic Zone.

Agenda item no. 197.1: Ratification of the minutes of the 196th meeting of the Unit Approval Committee held on 30th June, 2025.

Minutes of 196th UAC meeting were circulated to all the members. As no comments were received from members, the Committee ratified the minutes.

Agenda item no.197.2 (i): Request for permission of authorized operation and goods/services by M/s Tata Consultancy Service (TCS) Limited, Developer of M/s TCS SEZ, New Town, Rajarhat, Kolkata in terms of Instruction No. 50 of M/o Commerce & Industry, Department of Commerce.

Shri Debdut Gupta and Shri Rajesh Sarkar physically represented the Developer before the Committee. It was stated by the Developer that they require the goods namely Reinforcement, Concrete M25 grade and Concrete M40 grade on duty free basis for the purpose of construction of Phase II building inside their SEZ area.

Committee considered the proposal in terms of Instruction no. 50 dated 15.03.2010 of SEZ Section, Department of Commerce and the list of authorized operations for SEZ developers annexed thereto. It was observed that 'Construction of all type of Buildings in processing area' is one of the authorized operations for SEZ developers (Sl. no. 22 of the list) and the said goods are related to construction activities.

Committee approved the proposal, with the condition that the Developer will submit monthly progress report of their said construction activity to O/o Development Commissioner.



Agenda item no.197.2 (Sup-1): Non performance of M/s Antarctica Limited for financial year 2020-21 to 2023-24 [i.e. 1st to 4th year of current (6th) block]

Shri S.N. Rakshit virtually represented the Unit before the Committee.

Committee observed,

- i. That the Letter of Approval of Unit expired on 30.06.2025.
- ii. That the Unit has not performed throughout the current (6th) Block starting from 1st year of the Block i.e. from FY 2020-21 [zero exports and Net Foreign Exchange earning].
- iii. That the Unit has been issued a Show Cause Notice (SCN) on 13.01.2025 u/s 16 of the Special Economic Zones Act, 2005 for their said persistent contravention of Letter of Approval obligations by not making exports year-after-year.
- iv. That on 17.07.2025 the Unit appeared for Personal Hearing before Development Commissioner, Falta SEZ in terms of the SCN dated 13.01.2025. During course of hearing, they accepted their said non-performance and requested for cancellation of their Letter of Approval as they are unable to run the Unit.

Committee, therefore, cancelled Letter of Approval of the unit u/s 16 of the Special Economic Zones Act, 2005 and imposed penalty of Rs 10,000/- upon the unit in terms of the SCN dated 13.01.2025 and as per the provisions of Foreign Trade (Development and Regulations) Act, 1992 for their contravention of Letter of Approval obligations.
